

1066 mini-CAMPAIGN

BIG BATTLE RAVENFEAST

Introduction:

To capture the struggles of the three very important battles in 1066 that happened in quick succession (Fulford Gate, Stamford Bridge, and Hastings), try playing through these three game scenarios as a mini campaign. To do so, track and carry forward the casualties from battle to battle. For example, if the Norse lose two Huskarls at Fulford Gate, remove them from the Order of Battle in the Stamford Bridge scenario. Then for Hastings, replace the Saxon Order of battle with only the survivors of Stamford Bridge game.

Rewriting history:

If the Saxons win at Fulford Gate, the remnants ride to join the king to face the Normans at Hastings.

If the Norse win at Stamford Bridge, the remnants ride to face the Normans at Hastings

The sides:

One player team will control the Saxons in all the battles they are in.

The other player team will control the Norse for the battles they are in.

The Normans will be controlled by whichever player team they are not facing.

Victory:

This is a all or nothing campaign to see who will rule England. To those who remain standing at the conclusion of the Battle of Hastings go all the spoils.
